### Teacher Only Day

Thanks for making alternative arrangements for your child for our Teacher Only Day last Thursday. We had a day of learning about key parts of the brain in relation to emotional control and how this relates to readiness for learning. At school our children need to be largely free from anxiety. This includes having had plenty of sleep, being well hydrated (with water, not highly sweetened drinks), and having had nutritious food. To be free from anxiety they need confidence about the stability of home life *and* school life - confidence that they are cared for, and assurance of physical and emotional safety.
